IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

To declare the existence of an emergency with respect to the need to grant the request of the Mayor to extend the date by which the Mayor is required to submit to the Council the proposed budget for the government of the District of Columbia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005, which will identify information and documentation to be submitted to the Council with the proposed budget for the government of the District of Columbia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the Revised Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Submission Requirements Emergency Declaration Resolution of 2004".

Sec. 2. (a) Section 442(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 798; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.42(a)) ("Home Rule Act"), requires that the Mayor prepare and submit to the Council, and make available to the public, an annual budget for the District of Columbia government "at such time as the Council may direct."

(b) In the Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Submission Requirements Resolution of 2004, effective January 6, 2004 (Res. 15-384; 51 DCR 659) ("Resolution 15-384"), the Council established March 22, 2004 as the date by which the Mayor would be required to submit the annual budget and supporting documents. The Mayor has advised the Council that he needs additional time to prepare the annual budget and supporting materials required by Resolution 15-384.

(c) The impending March 22, 2004, deadline does not give the Council sufficient time to approve an extension of time through the ordinary legislative process, the process by which this matter was previously approved.

Sec. 3. The Council of the District of Columbia finds that the circumstances enumerated in section 2 constitute emergency circumstances making it necessary that the Revised Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Submission Requirements Emergency Resolution of 2004 be adopted on an emergency basis.

Sec. 4. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

March 17, 2004.

To extend, on an emergency basis, the date by which the Mayor shall submit to the Council the proposed budget for the government of the District of Columbia for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this resolution may be cited as the "Revised Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Submission Requirements Emergency Resolution of 2004".

Sec. 2. (a) The Mayor has advised the Council that he needs an additional week to prepare his proposed Fiscal Year 2005 Budget for submission to the Council.

(b) Pursuant to section 442(a) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (87 Stat. 798; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.42(a)) ("Home Rule Act"), the Council grants the request of the Mayor and extends the time from March 22, 2004, to March 29, 2004, for the Mayor to submit to the Council, and make available to the public, the proposed budget for the District government and related budget documents required by sections 442, 443, and 444 of the Home Rule Act (D.C. Official Code §§ 1-204.42, 1-204.43, and 1-204.44), for the fiscal year ending September 30, 2005. The proposed budget shall contain the information required by the Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Submission Requirements Resolution of 2004, effective January 6, 2004 (Res. 15-384; 51 DCR 659).

Sec. 3. Pursuant to section 446 of the Home Rule Act, the Council's 50 calendar day budget review period shall begin after the date that all materials required to be submitted by section 2 and the Fiscal Year 2005 Budget Submission Requirements Resolution of 2004, effective January 6, 2004 (Res. 15-384; 51 DCR 659), have been submitted in accordance with this resolution and the Council's rules.

Sec. 4. The Secretary to the Council of the District of Columbia shall transmit a copy of this resolution, upon its adoption, to the Office of the Mayor and to the Board of Education of the District of Columbia.

Sec. 5. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
