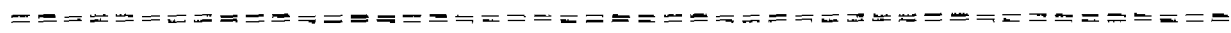


**COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA

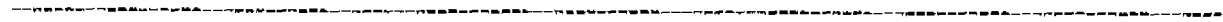
