

**ORIGINATING AGENCY:** Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia pursuant to section 422(6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (Pub. L. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(6) and (11) (2001)), and the "Debarment Procedures Emergency Amendment Act of 2003" (the "Act") (D.C. Act 15-153, 50 DCR 8730), or any substantially similar emergency, temporary or permanent versions of the Act, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

**I. APPOINTMENT.**

The following individuals are appointed to the Debarment and Suspension Panel ("Panel") established pursuant to the Act, and shall carry out the functions and duties of the Act:

1. The Deputy Mayor for Operations, or his or her designee, who shall act as Chair of the Panel,
2. The Chief Procurement Officer, or his or her designee,
3. The Director of the Office of Labor Relations and Collective Bargaining, or his or her designee,
4. The Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development, or his or her designee,
5. The Chief Financial Officer, or his or her designee, and
6. The head of each agency that would be directly and significantly affected by the proposed debarment or suspension, or his or her designee.



**II. EXERCISE OF AUTHORITY.**

The Chair of the Panel shall designate the agencies that would be directly and significantly affected by the proposed debarment or suspension. The decisions of the Panel shall be made by a majority vote of the Panel, and each member of the Panel shall have one vote. The Panel shall establish such procedures governing its consideration and deliberation of proposed debarments or suspensions as it deems appropriate.

**III. EFFECTIVE DATE.**

This Order shall become effective immediately and shall supersede all prior inconsistent Orders.
