Mayor's Order 2004-1  
January 5, 2004

**SUBJECT:** Establishment -- Blue Ribbon Task Force for Special Nutrition and  
Commodities Programs

**ORIGINATING AGENCY:** Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(2) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, as amended, Pub. L. No. 93-198, 87 Stat. 790, D.C. Official Code §1-204.22(2), (2001 ed.), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

**I. ESTABLISHMENT**

There is hereby established in the Executive Branch of the Government of the District of Columbia, within the Executive Office of the Mayor, the Blue Ribbon Task Force for Special Nutrition and Commodities Programs (hereinafter referred to as the "Task Force").

**II. PURPOSE**

The Task Force shall provide the Mayor recommendations for improved service delivery and expanded nutrition programs throughout the District of Columbia.

**III. FUNCTIONS**

The functions of the Task Force shall include:

- a. Analyzing overall program operations and organization of feeding programs in the District.
- b. Making recommendations on the establishment of a District-wide vision for nutrition services.
- c. Examining the current system, structures, problems and barriers to effective service provision, including the collaborative relationship between the federal government and the District government.

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- d. Identifying and benchmarking relevant and successful practices from comparable jurisdictions throughout the United States.
- e. Preparing and issuing a written report to the Mayor on or before April 30, 2004.

#### IV. COMPOSITION

- a. The Task Force shall be composed of not more than forty (40) members, appointed by the Mayor.
- b. The members appointed to the Task Force shall include representation from the following communities:
  1. Experts in nutrition and nutrition feeding programs;
  2. District government;
  3. Federal government;
  4. D.C. Public Schools;
  5. Other educational programs and institutions;
  6. Service providers of nutrition and feeding services;
  7. Non-for-profit institutions and organizations; and
  8. Community representatives.
- c. **Members** of the Task Force shall be residents of the District, or shall have some educational, social, service provider, cultural, or governmental nexus to the District.
- d. The following members shall serve as ex-officio, non-voting members on the Task Force:
  1. Chairperson, Council Committee on Education, Recreation & Libraries; and
  2. The Deputy Chief of Staff, Office of Policy & Legislative Affairs.

**V. TERMS**

- a. The Mayor shall appoint members to terms lasting until April 30, 2004, or until the final report is completed and transmitted to the Mayor, whichever is later.
- b. The Mayor may appoint members to fill vacancies in unexpired terms only for the remainder thereof.
- c. Government members appointed to the Task Force shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor and for the tenure of service in their government positions.

**VI. COMPENSATION**

Members of the Task Force shall serve without compensation.

**VII. ORGANIZATION**

- a. The Task Force shall be chaired jointly by the Deputy Mayor for Children, Youth, Families and Elders and the Executive Director, D.C. Central Kitchen. The joint Chairpersons shall serve in that capacity at the pleasure of the Mayor.
- b. The Task Force shall convene on the call of the Co-Chairpersons.
- c. The Co-Chairpersons shall convene meetings when and as necessary to effectuate the objectives of the Task Force.
- d. The Task Force may establish subcommittees as needed. Subcommittees may include persons who are not members of the full Task Force, provided that each subcommittee is chaired by a Commission member.
- e. The Task Force may establish its own bylaws and rules of procedure, subject to the approval of the Mayor or his designee.
- f. There shall be no voting by proxy.

**VIII. ADMINISTRATION**

- a. The Office of the Deputy Chief of Staff for Policy Legislative Affairs, Executive Office of the Mayor, shall provide administrative and staff support (research, document

production, coordination, and communication) to the Task Force.


- b. The State Education Office and the Office of Finance and Resource Management, Office of the Chief Financial Officer, shall provide technical support and assistance.
- c. The Task Force may utilize District public space to sponsor or hold meetings in accordance with District law and regulations.

**IX. SUNSET**

The Task Force shall sunset on May 1, 2004.

**X. EFFECTIVE DATE**

This Order shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* to December 1, 2003.

Official Code §1-204.22(6)), and Title VII of the Fiscal Year 2004 Budget Support Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2003, effective September 22, 2003 (D.C. Act 15-149; 50 DCR 8389), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Director of the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department is delegated the authority vested in the Mayor pursuant to Title VII of the Fiscal Year 2004 Budget Support Congressional Review Emergency Act of 2003, effective September 22, 2003 (D.C. Act 15-149; 50 DCR 8389) and any subsequent substantially similar statute, to provide training to non-District of Columbia agencies, organizations and individuals, and to establish fees to cover the costs of such training.
