Each of these bills were introduced by Councilmember Fenty and referred to the Committee on Consumer and Regulatory Affairs. They each involve the licensing and regulation of used car dealers by the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs.

The purpose of Bill 15-89 is to amend Title 16 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations to prohibit the issuance of new licenses to used car dealers, for a period of 3 years.

The purpose of Bill 15-92 is to amend Title 16 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations to establish that before renewing a used car dealer's license, the used car dealer would be required to obtain the approval of the Director; to have permanent fences surrounding the dealer's establishments; have licensed waste haulers; only to house cars in areas on used car lots with concrete surfacing; to have adequate lighting and other requirements the Director deems necessary to protect the integrity of the community in question; and provide a record to the Director containing a full description of all vehicles and parts that were purchased.

The purpose of Bill 15-671 is to amend Chapter 28 of Title 47 of the District of Columbia Official Code to create separate business license endorsement categories for motor

vehicle sales, service, and repair businesses; to establish a minimum size requirement for the issuance of a business license to a motor vehicle dealership; to regulate the outdoor storage of vehicles at motor vehicle repair businesses and motor vehicle dealerships; and to amend Title 28 of the District of Columbia Official Code to direct the Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs to report on its enforcement of certain regulations applicable to automobile dealerships.

Orange, Sr., Chairperson of the Committee on Government Operations, announces a Public Oversight Roundtable entitled, An Assessment: "The Administration of the District of Columbia's First in the Nation Primary". The Public Oversight Roundtable will be held on Friday, January 30, 2004 at 9:00 a.m., in the 5th Floor Council Chamber, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.

The purpose of the Public Oversight Roundtable is to receive a report from the District of Columbia Board of Elections and Ethics ("Board") relative to its implementation of the District of Columbia's "First in the Nation Primary." Legislation was introduced in Council Period XIV, amending Title 1 of the District of Columbia Official Code to change the dates for holding elections to allow the District of Columbia to hold the first Presidential Primary in the nation on Tuesday, January 13, 2004. This effort was intended to bring national attention to the fact that more than five hundred thousand (500,000) District residents do not have voting representation in the nation's bicameral legislature. The first in the nation primary provided a platform for District residents and elected officials to educate the nation on the denial of one of the most fundamental and basic rights possessed by all other citizens of the United States.

As a result of the date change, the District of Columbia Board of Elections and Ethics was required to adjust numerous requirements, pursuant to District election law, and to have touch-screen voting machines available for the visually impaired population in the District of Columbia. The requirement that touch screen machines be available was pursuant to the settlement agreement the District of Columbia government reached with

the American Association of People with Disabilities. The Board's report to the Committee will delineate the various procedural changes implemented by the Board to execute the election on January 13, 2004, and the introduction of touch screen voting machines to the District's electorate.
