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**NOTICE OF CONTRACT DISAPPROVAL RESOLUTION**

The Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the following resolution to disapprove a proposed contract submitted to the Council by the Mayor for approval was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 13, 2003. A Contract Summary for the proposed contract, CAS 15-148, was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 10, 2003. The proposed contract in the amount of \$1,117,421.25 is to provide weekly collection of recyclable ferrous and nonferrous metal, glass, plastic food and beverage containers, and paper products and deliver collected recyclables to a processing facility. Upon receipt of the proposed contract, the disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 15 days, excluding Saturday, Sundays, and legal holidays.

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**NOTICE OF CONTRACT DISAPPROVAL RESOLUTION**

The Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the following resolution to disapprove a proposed contract submitted to the Council by the Mayor for approval was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 14, 2003. The proposed contract, CA 15-152, is for a proposed lease that would transfer site control of the old Washington Convention Center to the Washington Convention Center Authority was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 14, 2003. The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 45 days starting on November 17, 2003.

The proposed contract will be deemed approved on January 23, 2004 unless the Council adopts a disapproval or approval resolution prior to that time.
