
SUBJECT: Condemnation of Real Property
(Lot 0001, Square 4038, Parcel 01420024)

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(11) (2001) and D.C. Official Code § 16-1314 (2001), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The District of Columbia shall establish a residential facility to house homeless city residents on certain real property to be acquired in the District of Columbia, and identified as Lot 0001 in Square 4038 and Parcel 01420024, with the address of 1355-1357 New York Avenue, N.E.
2. Because the District of Columbia has not been able to acquire the above-described interests in property at a price satisfactory to it, the Office of the Corporation Counsel shall initiate condemnation proceedings under the provisions of D.C. Official Code §§ 16-1301, *et seq.* (2001), or other appropriate authority, for the acquisition of the above-described property. Condemnation of the ownership interests in 1355-1357 New York Avenue, N.E., will permit the District to establish a residential facility to house homeless city residents and provide them with supportive services to start these District residents on the road to self-sufficiency thus benefiting the citizens of the District of Columbia.
3. In conjunction with the condemnation of the above-described property, the Office of the Corporation Counsel is hereby further authorized to file a Declaration of Taking in accordance with the provisions of D.C. Official Code § 16-1314 (2001), or other appropriate authority.
4. The cost of such acquisition and the expense of these proceedings shall be chargeable to the District of Columbia.

5. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Order shall become effective immediately.

SUBJECT: Establishment of a Compensation Review Committee

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Executive Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia pursuant to sections 422(2) and 422(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, approved December 24, 1973, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198; D.C. Official Code §§ 1-204.22(2) and 1-204.22(3)(2001), respectively, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

I. ESTABLISHMENT

There is hereby established in the Executive Office of the Mayor ("EOM"), the Compensation Review Committee, hereinafter referred to as the "CRC" or the "Committee."

II. PURPOSE

The CRC shall undertake a review of:

- (1) Proposed monetary awards in excess of two thousand dollars (\$2000); and
- (2) Proposed promotions and salary increases for employees earning more than ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) annually. The CRC shall transmit its final recommendations to the Mayor for his final determination to be made in accordance with section 422(3) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, approved December 24, 1973, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(3)(2001), and § 1902 of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979, D.C. Law 2-139; D.C. Official Code § 1-619.02 (2001), respectively.

III. DUTIES AND FUNCTIONS

- A. Review proposals from all subordinate departments and agencies for monetary awards to District employees in excess of two thousand dollars (\$2000);
- B. Review proposals from all subordinate departments and agencies for promotions and salary increases for District employees earning more than ninety thousand dollars (\$90,000) annually;
- C. Establish subcommittees or task forces as necessary and appropriate to carry out the responsibilities of the CRC;
- D. Submit final recommendations to the Mayor for proposed monetary awards, promotions, and salary increases for District employees; and
- E. Periodically review and recommend proposed policies and procedures to ensure consistency in the granting of incentive awards and the application of the performance management system for District employees.

IV. COMPOSITION

The CRC shall be composed of the City Administrator, the Chief of Staff of the EOM, the Deputy Mayors, the Director of the Office of Personnel ("DCOP"), or their respective delegates. In addition, the Mayor may designate such other persons to serve as members of the CRC as the Mayor deems appropriate to effectuate the objectives of this Order. The City Administrator shall be the Chair of the CRC, responsible for convening and conducting meetings of the Committee, so as to effectuate the objectives of this Order. The Director of the DCOP or his or her designee shall provide administrative support to the CRC, including tracking and recording the results of the Committee's deliberations.

V. TERMS


Each member of the CRC shall serve on the CRC for so long as he or she holds the position described above in Section IV.

VI. FREQUENCY OF MEETINGS

The CRC shall meet on the call of the Chair. The Chair shall convene meetings when and as necessary to effectuate the timely submission of recommendations to the Mayor.

VII. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Order shall become effective immediately.






