Notice of Reprogramming Disapproval

Councilmember Catania filed on August 5, 2003, PR 15-372, the "Reprogramming of \$2,000,000 of Fiscal Year 2003 Other Funds Budget Authority from the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development to the Department of Employment Services Disapproval Resolution of 2003" to disapprove Reprogramming 15-40, the "Reprogramming of \$2,000,000 of fiscal year 2003 other funds budget authority from the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development (DMPED) to the Department of Employment (DOES) both in the Economic Development and Regulation appropriation title". The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to October 1, 2003. If the Council does not adopt a resolution of approval or disapproval during this period, the reprogramming will be deemed approved.

RESOLVED, BY THE COUNCIL OF THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA, That this 3
resolution may be cited as the "Reprogramming of \$2,000,000 of Fiscal Year 2003 Other Funds 4
Budget Authority from the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic 5
Development to the Department of Employment Services Disapproval Resolution of 2003". 6

Sec. 2 Pursuant to section 47-363 of the D. C. Official Code, the Mayor transmitted to 7
the Council on July 31, 2003, a reprogramming request to reprogram \$2,000,000 from the Office 8
of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development to the Department of 9
Employment Services. The Council disapproves the reprogramming request. 10
