


SUBJECT: Realignment - Office of Local Business Development for the District of Columbia

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority to Solicit Gifts and Donations to Support Citizen Summit III

Office of the Mayor

ORIGINATING AGENCY:

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia pursuant to section 422(6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, approved December 24, 1973, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(6) and (11) (2001), and section 115 of the District of Columbia Appropriations Act, 2003, approved February 20, 2003, Pub. L. 108-7 (and any substantially identical successor law),

WHEREAS the Citizen Summit III will form the basis for the District government's preparation of its Strategic Plan, which establishes the budget priorities of the government, and will involve the active engagement of approximately 3000 District residents for the purposes of (a) providing input on plans for service improvement and neighborhood enhancement and (b) building partnerships with the private sector,

It is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. Notwithstanding Mayor's Order 2002-2, dated January 11, 2002, the authority to solicit, receive, and following approval by the Director of the Office of Partnerships and Grants Development, use gifts and donations to support the Citizen Summit III is hereby delegated to the Executive Director, Neighborhood Action, Executive Office of the Mayor. The Executive Director of Neighborhood Action may, in turn, delegate this authority to other individuals who are under the Executive Director's supervision. Gifts and donations solicited and received under this Order shall be used solely to supplement the authorized budget of the EOM for FY2003 and, after its approval, the authorized budget of the EOM for FY2004 with respect to holding the Citizen Summit III.
2. The solicitation and donation of funds pursuant to this Order shall be subject to the approval of the Director of the Office of Partnerships and Grants Development in accordance with procedures, rules and regulations promulgated by that Office, except as otherwise provided in Paragraph 1 of this Order.
3. Any donation of funds pursuant to this Order shall be drawn to the order of the District of Columbia Treasurer and shall be deposited, documented, used and accounted for in accordance with Mayor's Order 2002-2, dated January 11, 2002 and Mayor's Memorandum 2002-1, dated January 8, 2002. 
