Council Chairman Linda W. Cropp announces the scheduling of a public hearing by the Committee of the Whole on PR 15-370, the "Southwest Waterfront Plan Approval Resolution of 2003." The public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, September 23, 2003, at 10:00 a.m., in the Council Chamber, located on the 5th floor of The John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.

PR 15-370, introduced by Chairman Cropp at the request of the Mayor, would approve the Southwest Waterfront Plan, which is the product of a two-year planning process initiated by the Office of Planning and engaged with Southwest residents and other stakeholders as part of the overall Anacostia Waterfront Initiative. The Southwest Waterfront Plan envisions new public plazas, parks and riverfront promenades, as well as new development that includes approximately 800 housing units, 233,000 square feet of retail uses, a 215,000 square foot hotel, and 200,000 square feet of cultural uses.

Persons presenting testimony may be limited to 3 minutes in order to permit each witness an opportunity to be heard.
