Summary: Serve DC announces the availability of AmeriCorps*State Competitive funding for fiscal year 2009–2010 to eligible organizations. New applicants with high-quality proposals will compete nationally with other State and National programs for \$40,328,000 of funds made available through Serve DC and the Corporation on National and Community Service (CNCS). The total amount of the grant must not exceed \$12,600 per Member Service Years. Interested applicants can access Serve DC’s prime application in eGrants by visiting www.americorps.gov.

AmeriCorps is a national service network that provides full- and less than full-time opportunities for participants, called members, to serve their communities and build the capacity of nonprofit organizations to meet local environmental, educational, public safety, homeland security, or other human needs. Within these five issue areas, programs may submit proposals that address specific problems of local communities.

Match Requirement: All program costs require at least a 24% cash or in-kind match during each of the first three years of funding, with match requirements increasing incrementally after year three. Programs reach a maximum 50% minimum match level during the 10th year of funding.

Criteria for Eligible Applicants: Eligible applicants are local nonprofit organizations and/or state and local units of government. Programs applying to Serve DC for funding *must* operate the program only within the District of Columbia.

An organization described in Section 501 (c) (4) of the Internal Revenue Code, 26 U.S.C. 501 (c) (4), that engages in lobbying activities is not eligible to apply, serve as a host site for members, or act in any type of supervisory role in the program. **Individuals are not eligible to apply.**

All eligible applicants must meet all of the applicable requirements contained in the application guidelines and instructions. The application guidelines and instructions will be available on September 12, 2008. **The deadline for submission is October 31, 2008, by 5:00 pm.** Applications must be entered in to the CNCS eGrants online system. Late applications will not be accepted. An application is considered late at 5:01 p.m.
