ABBREVIATED NOTICE OF INTENT TO CONSIDER LEGISLATION

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice of its intention to take action in less than fifteen (15) days on PR17-1145, the "Reprogramming of \$1,740,000 within the Department of Corrections Disapproval Resolution of 2008" in order to consider the proposed resolution at the legislative meeting scheduled for Tuesday, November 18, 2008. The Council needs to act on this disapproval resolution expeditiously in order for there to be consideration prior to when the reprogramming is deemed approved.

Notice of Reprogramming Disapproval

Councilmember Mendelson and Councilmember Barry filed on November 3, 2008, PR 17-1145 the "Reprogramming No. 17-165 Disapproval Resolution of 2008" to disapprove Reprogramming 17-165. The request to reprogram \$1,740,000 of FY 2008 Special Purposes Revenue funds budget authority in the Department of Corrections (DOC) from Object Class 0070 (Equipment) to Object Class 0041 (Contracts) was filed in the Chairman's Office on October 27, 2008. This reprogramming will enable the Public Safety Cluster to have a balanced budget in FY 2008.

The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 30 days, ending on Wednesday, November 26, 2008. If the Council does not adopt a resolution of approval or disapproval during this period, the reprogramming will be deemed approved on Thursday, November 27, 2008.

A reprogramming will become effective on the 15th day after official receipt unless a Member of the Council files a notice of disapproval of the request which extends the Council's review period to 30 days. If such notice is given, a reprogramming will become effective on the 31st day after its official receipt unless a resolution of approval or disapproval is adopted by the Council prior to that time.
