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**Reprog. 17-168:** Request to reprogram \$1,355,197 in FY 2008 Local funds budget authority within the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) was filed in the Chairman's Office on November 26, 2008. The reprogramming will provide sufficient budget authority for the department to ensure that funds are loaded in the correct areas to cover administrative costs.
