REVISED NOTICE OF FINAL RULEMAKING

**FORMAL CASE NO. 1002, IN THE MATTER OF THE JOINT APPLICATION OF
PEPCO AND THE NEW RC, INC. FOR AUTHORIZATION AND APPROVAL OF
MERGER TRANSACTION**

1. On November 26, 2008, the Public Service Commission of the District of Columbia (“Commission”) approved the application of the Potomac Electric Power Company (“PEPCO” or the “Company”) to revise the Company’s retail transmission rates.¹ Consistent with that Order the rates were to become effective upon publication of a Notice of Final Rulemaking (“NOFR”) in the *D.C. Register*.² The NOFR was published on December 5, 2008, at 55 *D.C. Reg.* 12276.

2. On December 3, 2008, PEPCO advised the Commission that “PEPCO will need until December 15 to make the necessary internal changes to implement the [revised retail transmission] rates,” and requested that any Notice of Final Rulemaking not be made effective before the December 15 date.³ By Order issued December 11, 2008, the Commission granted Pepco’s request and indicated that the Commission would extend the effective date of the rates through issuance of a Revised NOFR.⁴

3. This Revised NOFR incorporates by reference the substance of the December 5, 2008, NOFR and changes the effective date of the NOFR from December 5, 2008 to the date of publication of this Revised Notice of Final Rulemaking in the *D.C. Register*.
