Notice is hereby given that, pursuant to 20 DCMR 800.5(f), the Air Quality Division (AQD) of the District Department of the Environment (DDOE) located at 51 N Street, NE., Washington, D.C., intends to increase asbestos abatement fees, effective January 1, 2009.

The new fees will be as follows:

- 1) For projects removing between 161 and 1,600 square feet, or 261 and 2,600 linear feet, or up to 35 cubic feet of RACM, the fee will be \$641.00.
- 2) For projects removing greater than 1,600 square feet, 2,600 linear feet, or 350 cubic feet of RACM, the fee will be \$1,122.00.
- 3) A one year blanket permit fee for a business entity that has entered into a contract for asbestos abatement at a specific site will be \$1,122.00.

“Know Your Rights” Training Grant

Background information on the grant:

The Mayor’s Office on Asian and Pacific Islander Affairs (OAPIA) received \$18,000 in grant funding from the Office on Human Rights (OHR) to be awarded competitively to a community-based organization(s) (CBOs) under its “Know Your Rights” community education and outreach training initiative. The purpose of the “Know Your Rights” community education and outreach trainings is to train staff and community members at CBOs, faith-based organizations (FBOs), and/or public service organizations throughout the District of Columbia who provide services to limited-English proficient (LEP) and/or non-English proficient (NEP) individuals. OHR recognizes that the individuals most educated about the law are often not the staff working with the LEP or NEP individual directly. In order for LEP/NEP individuals to obtain the most efficient, effective and direct access to knowing their rights and recourse under the D.C. Language Access Act of 2004, the OHR must ensure that, at minimum, all frontline staff at the CBOs, FBOs and/or public service organizations where LEP/NEP populations frequent, as well as the LEP/NEP populations themselves, be well-versed and trained in the law.

Amount of grant funds available and number of awards:

OAPIA expects to award one grant for \$18,000 to an eligible community-based organization.

Eligible organizations and entities:

Nonprofit (501(c)3) organization(s) located in the District of Columbia that:

- Serves limited-English proficient and/or non-English proficient individuals
- Has capacity to work effectively with language minority populations particularly those under the D.C. Language Access Act
- Has experience working with District Agencies

Program scope:

The scope of the grant will be to provide a minimum of 10 “Know Your Rights” trainings which will train no less than 2000 individuals comprised of LEP/NEP residents and/or business owners and staff at CBOs, FBOs and/or public service organizations in the District that serve LEP/NEP individuals. Additionally, the training will target, at minimum, 3 of the 6 following languages under the DC Language Access Act: Amharic, Chinese, Spanish, French, Vietnamese, and Korean.

**District of Columbia Proposed State Plan for Administration of the
Block Grant for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families**

The District of Columbia Department of Human Services Income Maintenance Administration will be amending the District of Columbia State Plan for Administration of the Block Grant for Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF) published in the November 21, 2008 issue of the *D.C. Register*. The amendment will reduce the payment levels for TANF in accordance with the “*Fiscal Year 2009 Balanced Budget Support Emergency Amendment Act of 2008*”, DC Act 17-572. The reduction eliminates the increases in payment levels that became effective November 1, 2008.
