The Director of the District Department of the Environment (DDOE) is providing notice that the public hearing scheduled for April 1, 2009 in the *D. C. Register* (56 DCR 1987) has been rescheduled to April 13, 2009. DDOE is inviting the public to a hearing to present its views and comments on the change of the current stormwater fee to an impervious area based stormwater fee basis. DDOE published the proposed fee changes in the rulemaking section of the March 6, 2009 *D.C. Register* (56 DCR 1991). The public hearing will be held at 6:00 P.M on Monday, April 13, 2009, in the 6th floor conference room of the District Department of the Environment, at 51 N Street, NE, Washington, D.C. Persons wishing to testify should provide his or her name, address, telephone number, and the organization he or she represents, if any, in writing to the attention of Dr. Hamid Karimi at the DDOE address above, or via e-mail at hamid.karimi@dc.gov, by 4 P.M. on April 10, 2009. Presentations by individuals shall be limited to five (5) minutes. Presentations on behalf of organizations shall be limited to ten (10) minutes. So there will be time for all interested parties to be heard, presentations should be addressed to relevant issues and summarize extensive written material. Oral statements will be heard and considered, but for accuracy of the record, all statements should be submitted in writing to the address or e-mail above. Such written statements are to be clearly marked "Stormwater Fees" and received by April 13, 2009. The Director will consider all comments prior to publishing final rulemaking.
