

**"Metropolitan Police Department Subpoena
Limitation Temporary Amendment Act of 2009"**

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, P.L. 93-198 (the Charter), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill 18-24 on first and second readings January 6, 2009 and February 3, 2009, respectively. The legislation was deemed approved without the signature of the Mayor on February 24, 2009, pursuant to Section 404(e) of the Charter, the bill became Act 18-20 and was published in the March 6, 2009 edition of the D.C. Register (Vol. 56, page 1945). Act 18-20 was transmitted to Congress on March 5, 2009 for a 30-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(1) of the Home Rule Act.
