

D.C. LAW 17-387

Firearms Control Temporary Amendment Act of 2009

Pursuant to Section 412 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, P.L. 93-198 (the Charter), the Council of the District of Columbia adopted Bill 17-887 on first and second readings July 15, 2008, September 16, 2008 and October 7, 2008, respectively. Following the signature of the Mayor on October 20, 2008, pursuant to Section 404(e) of the Charter, the bill became Act 17-536 and was published in the November 7, 2008 edition of the D.C. Register (Vol. 55, page 11410). Act 17-536 was transmitted to Congress on January 30, 2009 for a 60-day review, in accordance with Section 602(c)(2) of the Home Rule Act.

The Council of the District of Columbia hereby gives notice that the 60-day Congressional review period has ended, and Act 17-536 is now D.C. Law 17-387, effective May 15, 2009.
