Notice of Reprogramming Disapproval

Councilmember Barry filed on July 8, 2009, PR 18-410 The "Reprogramming of \$46,160,991 for the Office of Property Management Disapproval Resolution of 2009 " to disapprove Reprogramming 18-34. The request to reprogram \$46,160,991 of capital budget authority and allotment between various capital projects owned and implemented by the Office of Property Management (OPM) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on July 1, 2009. This reprogramming will ensure that OPM realigns its capital budget with budget corrections required following a study of historical budgets in the financial system of record (SOAR) and actual appropriated amounts.

The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 30 days, ending on Friday, July 31, 2009. If the Council does not adopt a resolution of approval or disapproval during this period, the reprogramming will be deemed approved on Saturday, August 1, 2009.
