The Alcoholic Beverage Control Board (Board) will conduct a public hearing at the above-stated date and time to receive comment on a proposed rulemaking that would create two (2) new food sales requirement definitions in Chapter 21 of Title 23 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations. Specifically, the proposed rulemaking defines what constitutes a minimal lack of compliance and a substantial lack of compliance with the statutory food sales requirements set forth in D.C. Official Code §§ 25-101(43) and 25-113. The proposed rule also seeks to define the terms “minimal lack of compliance” and “substantial lack of compliance,” which are currently contained in 23 DCMR § 2101 (2004).
