



By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by Section 422(6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code §§ 1-204.22(6) and (11) (2008 Supp.); and pursuant to section 7 of the Child Development Facilities Regulation Act of 1998 (hereinafter "the Act"), effective April 13, 1999, D.C. Law 12-215, D.C. Official Code § 7-2036 (2008 repl.), it is hereby

**ORDERED** that:

1. The Mayor's authority to promulgate rules to implement the Act is delegated to the State Superintendent of Education or his or her designee pursuant to section 7(a) of the Act, D.C. Official Code § 7-2036(a) (2008 repl.).
2. This Order supersedes Mayor's Order 2000-124, dated August 3, 2000, and any other previously issued Mayor's Orders to the extent such provisions are inconsistent with this Order.
3. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall be effective immediately.

**SUBJECT:** Re-Designation of the District of Columbia Office of Property Management as the District of Columbia Department of Real Estate Services

**ORIGINATING AGENCY:** Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by sections 422(2) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(2) (2007 Repl.), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The District of Columbia Office of Property Management, established under section 1801 of the Office of Property Management Establishment Act of 1998 (D.C. Law 12-175; D.C. Official Code § 10-1001), is re-designated as the Department of Real Estate Services. The title for the head of the Office of Property Management shall be changed from the "Chief Property Management Officer" to the "Director, District of Columbia Department of Real Estate Services."
2. Robin-Eve Jasper, appointed as Chief Property Management Officer pursuant to Mayor's Order 2008-159, dated December 1, 2008, is re-designated as Director, Department of Real Estate Services.
3. All references in statutes, regulations, rules, and orders to the "Office of Property Management" or "District of Columbia Office of Property Management," and the "Chief Property Management Officer" or "Director, Office of Property Management" shall henceforth refer, respectively, to the District of Columbia Department of Real Estate Services; and the Director, District of Columbia Department of Real Estate Services.
4. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately and shall supersede all prior orders to the extent of any inconsistency.

**SUBJECT:** Designation of Agency to Receive Federal Stimulus Grants

**ORIGINATING AGENCY:** Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by sections 422(4) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, Pub. L. No. 93-198, 87 Stat. 790; D.C. Official Code §§ 1-204.22(4) and (11), and consistent with section 106(i)(2) of the Broadband Data Improvement Act (BDIA), approved October 10, 2008 (Pub. L. No. 110-385, 122 Stat. 4102; 47 U.S.C. § 1304 (i)(2)), and section 6001(e)(1)(a) of Division B of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 (ARRA), approved February 17, 2009 (Pub. L. No. 111-5, 123 Stat. 512, 47 U.S.C. § 1305(e)(1)(a)), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

**I. PURPOSE AND SCOPE**

The purpose of this Order is to designate an agency of the District of Columbia Government to receive grants pursuant to the BDIA and the ARRA.

**II. REQUIREMENTS FOR DISTRICT AGENCIES**


- A. The BDIA established the State Broadband and Development Grant Program to promote broadband availability and adoption. Section 106(b)(1) of the BDIA directs the Secretary of Commerce to award grants to "eligible entities" to fund initiatives to identify and track the availability and adoption of broadband services in the entities' jurisdictions. Section 106(i)(2) of the BDIA defines "eligible entity" as "an agency or instrumentality of a State, or a municipality or other subdivision" that is also "the single eligible entity of the [jurisdiction] that has been designated by the [jurisdiction] to receive a grant under [the BDIA]." By this Order, I designate the Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO) as the District of Columbia Government's "eligible entity" to receive a grant under the BDIA.
- B. Section 6001 of Division B of the ARRA established the Broadband Technology Opportunities Program (BTOP) to accelerate broadband deployment to unserved and underserved areas. Section 6001(e)(1)(A) states, "To be eligible for a grant under the program, an applicant shall . . . be a state or political subdivision thereof, [or] the District of Columbia . . .". At the request of the City Administrator, OCTO is leading the District's efforts to obtain BTOP funding for the District. By this Order, I authorize OCTO to apply for and receive BTOP funds.

**III. INCONSISTENT ORDERS SUPERSEDED**

This Order shall supersede all pre-existing Orders to the extent of any inconsistency.

**IV. EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately.
