


SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority – Grant Making Authority to Department of Parks and Recreation

Official Code § 38-172 (b) (2008 Supp.), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Chancellor of the District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) is hereby delegated the authority vested in the Mayor pursuant to Resolution No. R17-0933, enacted by the District of Columbia Council on December 16, 2008, to execute a lease between the District of Columbia and KIPP DC, a public charter school, for real property more commonly known as the Douglass School and located at 2600-2620 Douglass Road, S.E. in the District of Columbia.

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority – Waiver of District Government Claims**ORIGINATING AGENCY:** Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(2) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(2) (2008 Supp.), and by section 2901 *et seq.* of the District of Columbia Government Comprehensive Merit Personnel Act of 1978, as amended, effective March 3, 1979, D.C. Law 2-139, D.C. Official Code § 1-629.01 *et seq.* (2006 Repl.). it is hereby **ORDERED** that:


1. The Mayor's authority under D.C. Official Code § 1-629.01 *et seq.* (2006 Repl.) to waive, in whole or in part, a claim of the government against a current or former employee of the District government arising under D.C. Official Code § 1-629.02 (2006 Repl.) is hereby delegated as follows:
 - a. The Director of the Office of Pay and Retirement Services (OPRS), Office of the Chief Financial Officer (OCFO), shall have authority to grant or to deny, with OCFO approval, a requested waiver of any amount less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00);
 - b. The Director of the D.C. Department of Human Resources (Director, DCHR) shall have the authority to deny a requested waiver of any amount between one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00). However, the Director, DCHR, shall have authority to grant a requested waiver of any amount between one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00) and five thousand dollars (5,000.00) with the concurrence of the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) or his or her designee;
 - c. The Director, DCHR, shall have authority to deny a requested waiver of any amount over five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00). However, the Director, DCHR, shall have authority to grant a requested waiver of any amount that exceeds five thousand dollars (\$5,000.00) with the concurrence of both the CFO, and the Mayor or the City Administrator, or their designees.
2. The OCFO shall designate the Director, OPRS, or any "at-will" employee of the OCFO, as the District of Columbia's Overpayment Reconciliation Officer. The Overpayment Reconciliation Officer is hereby delegated the Mayor's authority and duties specified in D.C. Official Code §§ 1-629.02 and 1-629.04 (2006 Repl.). Neither the Director, DCHR,

nor any employee designated the authority as outlined in paragraphs 1(b) and (c) above, shall have any direct involvement in determining the existence of any debt under D.C. Official Code §§ 1-629.02 and 1-629.04 (2006 Repl.). All decisions made pursuant to this Order concerning the denial of a waiver shall constitute the final administrative decisions of the District of Columbia government, and are not subject to further administrative appeal.

3. Except as otherwise noted in this Order, the authority delegated in paragraph 1 (a) of this Order may be re-delegated to any "at will" employee in the OPRS. Additionally, the authority delegated to the Director, DCHR, in paragraphs 1 (b) and (c) of this Order may be re-delegated to any "at-will" employee in the DCHR other than the Overpayment Reconciliation Officer, or any other person responsible for determining the existence of a government debt pursuant to D.C. Official Code §§ 1-629.02 and 1-629.04 (2006 Repl.).
4. This Order supersedes Mayor's Order 99-220, dated December 30, 1999.
5. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately.





Official Code §§ 47-340.26-36 (2001)) (hereinafter cited as the "Income Tax Bond Act"), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Chief Financial Officer of the District of Columbia is delegated the authority vested in the Mayor pursuant to the Income Tax Bond Act, to take any action, execute (except for the execution of Bonds) and deliver agreements, documents and instruments as required by or incidental to the issuance of any Bonds authorized by the Income Tax Bond Act, perform any covenants contained in the Income Tax Bond Act, and negotiate the sale of any Bonds as authorized by the Income Tax Bond Act, including any amendments to such agreements, documents, instruments, or covenants. For purposes of this Order, the term "Bonds" shall have the same meaning as stated in the Income Tax Bond Act.
2. In the absence or disability of the Chief Financial Officer, the Deputy Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer of the District of Columbia is delegated the authority to execute the powers and duties delegated to the Chief Financial Officer as provided in this Order.
3. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective *nunc pro tunc* to March 3, 2009.

SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority pursuant to D.C. Law 3-30, the Animal Control Act of 1979

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(6) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(6) (2008 Supp.) and the Animal Control Act of 1979, effective October 18, 1979, D.C. Law 3-30, D.C. Official Code § 8-1801 (2008 Repl.) ("Act"), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Director of the Department of Health, is delegated the authority vested in the Mayor under the Act, including the authority to:
 - (a) Inspect the Animal Care and Control Agency to determine compliance with District laws, regulations, policies, and contractual obligations pursuant to section 3(b)(2) of the Act;
 - (b) Implement the annual free anti-rabies clinics under section 4(b) of the Act;
 - (c) Issue grants to appropriate animal welfare organizations that are experienced in subsidized sterilization efforts under section 5(j)(4)(B) of the Act;
 - (d) Issue licenses, revise the schedule of fees, and collect fees under section 5 of the Act;
 - (e) Impound animals and take all other required actions related to impoundment under section 6 of the Act;
 - (f) Issue rules to implement the Act pursuant to sections 6 and 14a of the Act;
 - (g) Release animals for adoption under section 8 of the Act;
 - (h) Issue permits for moving, displaying, exhibiting or otherwise moving animals in the District as part of a circus, carnival, or other special performance or event under section 9(k) of the Act;
 - (i) Issue animal hobby permits and collect fees under section 10 of the Act;

- (j) Implement an education and incentive program under section 11 of the Act;
and
 - (k) Enforce the penalty provisions in sections 12 and 13 of the Act.
2. The Director may further delegate this authority to a subordinate within the Department of Health or to the District of Columbia Animal Care and Control Agency established under section 3 of the Act.
 3. This Order supersedes Mayor's Order 2000-97, dated June 14, 2000.
 4. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This order shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* from December 5, 2008.
