





II. **Requirements:**

The Office of Contracting and Procurement, with the support of the District Department of the Environment, shall aggressively explore opportunities for procuring goods and services that have a lesser or reduced negative effect on human health and the environment, and shall actively promote the purchase of EPPS to the maximum extent possible and feasible. Acquisitions of goods and services shall consider, along with the traditional concerns of price, performance, and availability: human health, pollution reduction, the conservation of natural resources, waste-stream diversion, and the use of sustainable environmental practices among District suppliers.

III. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately.






By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(6) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, P. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(6), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. **SERVICE OF PROCESS:**

- a. When the Mayor is a named party in a civil action, the Secretary of the District of Columbia is hereby designated to accept Service of Process on the Mayor's behalf.
- b. When the Mayor is served, not as a named party, but on behalf of the District of Columbia under Rule 4(j)(1) of the Superior Court Rules of Civil Procedure, the Attorney General is hereby designated to accept Service of Process on the Mayor's behalf.
- c. When the Mayor is served, not as a named party, but on behalf of the District of Columbia under Rule 4(j)(2) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Attorney General is hereby designated to accept Service of Process on the Mayor's behalf.
- d. Whenever a business entity required to maintain a registered agent in the District of Columbia fails to appoint or maintain a registered agent in the District of Columbia, or whenever such registered agent cannot with reasonable diligence be found at the registered office, and the Mayor, therefore, has become an agent upon whom process may be served against the business entity, the Superintendent of Corporations at the District of Columbia Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs is hereby designated to accept Service of Process on the Mayor's behalf.
- e. All actions taken by the Department of Motor Vehicles for the Department of Public Works by accepting Service of Process on behalf of the Department of Public Works shall be ratified *nunc pro tunc* to March 26, 1999.
- f. The Director of the Department of Motor Vehicles is hereby designated to accept Service of Process under section 7 of the Motor Vehicle Safety Responsibility Act of the District of Columbia, D.C. Official Code § 50-1301.07.

- g. Each officer designated in this Order to accept Service of Process may delegate said authority to a responsible subordinate by filing with the Mayor and the Clerk of the Superior Court, the name, title, and address of said subordinate.
 - h. All actions heretofore taken by the Superintendent of Corporations on behalf of the Mayor to accept Service of Process on any corporation, limited liability company, or limited liability partnership are hereby ratified *nunc pro tunc* to July 23, 1991.
 - i. All prior Mayor's Orders and Mayor's Memoranda relating to the handling of Service of Process, including specifically Mayor's Order 91-130, as amended by Mayor's Order 2009-9, dated January 29, 2009, but not limited thereto, are hereby superseded to the extent of any inconsistency between such prior Orders and Memoranda and the terms of this Order.
2. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately.





SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority to the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development – Acquisition, Disposition, and Lease of Real Property

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by sections 422(6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code §§ 1-204.22 (6) and (11) and 1-204.49(2) (2008 Supp.), section 1 of An Act Authorizing the sale of certain real estate in the District of Columbia no longer needed for public purposes, approved August 5, 1939 (53 Stat. 1211; D.C. Official Code § 10-801 (2008 Supp.)), sections 5(b) and (c) and 6(b) of the Community Development Act of 1975, effective December 16, 1975 (D.C. Law 1-39; D.C. Official Code §§ 6-1004(b) and (c) and 6-1005(b)) (2008 Repl.) (“Community Development Act”), and section 1(c) of An Act to grant additional powers to the Commissioners of the District of Columbia, and for other purposes, approved December 20, 1944 (58 Stat. 819; D.C. Official Code § 1-301.01(c) (2006 Repl.)), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development (“Deputy Mayor”) is hereby delegated the authority to:
 - a. Acquire real property for the purpose of community development, neighborhood revitalization, or economic development projects or programs within the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development, including acquisitions in furtherance of the New Communities Initiative, Great Streets Initiative, or any capital project implemented by the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development;
 - b. Sell, convey, lease (inclusive of options) for a period of greater than 20 years, exchange, or otherwise dispose of property that is in the inventory of the Deputy Mayor;
 - c. Lease any building or land in the inventory of the Deputy Mayor; and
 - d. Implement community development, neighborhood revitalization, and economic development projects consistent with a Community Development Program approved by the Council under the Community Development Act (including projects for which the responsibility for implementation is transferred to the Deputy Mayor pursuant to a memorandum of understanding with another District agency), including the acquisition, construction, reconstruction, or installation of public works, facilities, and site or other improvements and the clearance, demolition, removal, and rehabilitation of buildings and improvements.
2. Real property acquired pursuant to paragraph 1.a of this Order shall become part of the inventory, and shall be under the management and control, of the Deputy Mayor.

- 3. The Deputy Mayor may further delegate all or a part of his or her authority under this Mayor's Order to subordinates under his or her jurisdiction.
- 4. a. Notwithstanding the foregoing, this Order shall not supersede nor terminate the authority provided to the Director of the Department of Housing and Community Development ("Director") by Mayor's Order 76-111 (May 3, 1976); Mayor's Order 90-178 (November 19, 1990); and District of Columbia Reorganization No. 3 of 1975 (July 3, 1975), as it relates to the operations and authorities of the Department of Housing and Community Development. The authority delegated to the Deputy Mayor under the Community Development Act pursuant to this Order shall be concurrent with the authority of the Director. The Director shall coordinate regularly with the Deputy Mayor with respect to the exercise or potential exercise of the authority of the Director to acquire real property under the Community Development Act. In the event of a conflict between the authority of the Deputy Mayor and the authority of the Director to acquire real property under the Community Development Act, the Deputy Mayor shall determine whether and how the authority shall be exercised.
- b. This Order shall not supersede nor terminate the authority of the Office of Property Management ("OPM") provided by prior Mayor's Orders or Title 10 of the District of Columbia Official Code, D.C. Official Code § 10-1001 *et seq.* ("existing authority of OPM"); to the extent that any of the authority delegated to the Deputy Mayor under this Order is coextensive with any existing authority of OPM, the authority delegated to the Deputy Mayor under this Order shall be concurrent with the authority of OPM.
- 5. Except as set forth in paragraph 4.a and b of this Order, this Order supersedes all previous Mayor's Orders to the extent of any inconsistency.
- 6. Mayor's Order 2008-136, issued October 20, 2008, is rescinded.
- 7. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* to October 20, 2008.







Official Code § 2-302.08(a)(1)), section 2 of the Confirmation Act of 1978, effective March 3, 1979 (D.C. Law 2-142; D.C. Official Code § 1-523.01), and Resolution of the Council of the District of Columbia 17-681, dated July 1, 2008, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. **CHARLES JAMES WILLOUGHBY** is appointed Inspector General and shall serve in that capacity for a term to end May 19, 2014.
2. This order supersedes Mayor's Order 2008-79, dated May 22, 2008.
3. This Order shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* to July 1, 2008.
