Council Chairman Vincent C. Gray announces a public hearing by the Committee of the Whole on PR 18-391, the "Florida Avenue Market Small Area Plan Approval Resolution of 2009" The hearing is scheduled for Thursday, September 24, 2009, at 2:00 p.m., in the Council Chamber, Room 500 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W.

PR 18-391, introduced by Chairman Gray at the request of the Mayor, would approve a small area plan for the Florida Avenue Market in Ward 5, which is an approximately 40-acre area located adjacent to the neighborhoods of Ivy City (including the Gallaudet campus community), Trinidad, and NoMa. The boundaries of the site are Florida Avenue NE to the south, New York Avenue NE to the north, 6th Street NE to the east, and 3rd Street NE to the west. The plan, which has been developed by the Office of Planning in collaboration with community stakeholders and District government agencies, provides a framework for the strategic redevelopment of the Florida Avenue Market into a mixed use neighborhood that may include new housing, retail, office, entertainment and wholesale food uses, while preserving the historic and retail character of the area.
