## Notice of Reprogramming Request

Pursuant to DC Official Code Sec 47-361 et seq. of the Reprogramming Policy Act of 1990, the Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the Mayor has transmitted the following reprogramming request(s)

A reprogramming will become effective on the 15<sup>th</sup> day after official receipt unless a Member of the Council files a notice of disapproval of the request which extends the Council's review period to 30 days. If such notice is given, a reprogramming will become effective on the 31<sup>st</sup> day after its official receipt unless a resolution of approval or disapproval is adopted by the Council prior to that time.

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**Reprog. 18-46:** Request to reprogram \$4,000,000 in FY 2009 Local funds budget authority within the Department of Human Services was filed in the Office of the Secretary on July 31, 2009. This reprogramming will make funding available to support the Community Partnership contract for the homeless services in the Homeless Services Administration.

**Reprog. 18-47:** Request to reprogram \$11,401,321 of capital budget authority and allotment within the Office of Property Management was filed in the Office of the Secretary on July 31, 2009. This reprogramming will consolidate and streamline UDC's capital budget management and support the overall budget for the Permanent Improvements – Van Ness Campus (project U0813C).

**Reprog. 18-48:** Request to reprogram \$1,260,173.54 of Local funds budget authority within the Office of Property Management (OPM) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on July 31, 2009. This reprogramming will provide budget authority to fund deficits in electricity and gas expenditures that are currently higher than were originally projected.

**Reprog. 18-49:** Request to reprogram \$150,000 of Fiscal Year 2009 Special Purpose Revenue funds budget authority from the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) to the District of Columbia Public Library (DCPL) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on July 31, 2009. This reprogramming will provide DCPL with budget authority to align with revenue to permit additional expenditures in three DCPL Special Purposes Revenue funds.

**Reprog. 18-50:** Request to reprogram \$12,653,093 of capital budget authority and allotment within the Department of Transportation was filed in the Office of the Secretary on July 31, 2009. This reprogramming is necessary to move available balances from inactive projects to new projects established in SOAR, as well as to align capital budgets in SOAR with what has been approved by Council for projects involving tree pruning; dead and hazardous tree removal; tree planting; curbs, sidewalks, and alleys; local pavement restoration, reconstruction, and resurfacing; streetlights; a street traffic study; and neighborhood streetscape projects.
