A reprogramming will become effective on the 15th day after official receipt unless a Member of the Council files a notice of disapproval of the request which extends the Council's review period to 30 days. If such notice is given, a reprogramming will become effective on the 31st day after its official receipt unless a resolution of approval or disapproval is adopted by the Council prior to that time.

Reprog. 18-58: Request to reprogram \$2,267,181 of Special Purpose Revenue funds within the District Department of the Environment for the Energy Assistance Trust Fund (EATF) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on September 22, 2009. This reprogramming is needed due to the July 2009 Council amendment of the Clean and Affordable Energy (CAEA) section (c) (2) and section (f), which allows for payment of FY 2008 RAD program costs of \$1,022,428 by using the fund balance, and increase in revenue collection for FY 2009 to support the current year program implementation of \$1,244,753 above the previously planned level.
