October 5, 2009


ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(6) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, as amended, (87 Stat. 790; Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(6) (2001)) and pursuant to section 13 of the Fiscal Year 2010 Tax Revenue Anticipation Notes Emergency Act of 2009, D.C. Act 18-193, effective October 5, 2009 (hereinafter cited as the "Notes Act"), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Chief Financial Officer of the District of Columbia is delegated the authority vested in the Mayor pursuant to the Notes Act, to take any action, and execute and deliver agreements, documents and instruments as required by or incidental to the issuance of any notes authorized by the Notes Act, perform any covenants contained in the Notes Act, and negotiate the sale of any notes pursuant to a purchase contract as authorized by the Notes Act, including any amendments to such agreements, documents, instruments, covenants or purchase contracts.
2. In the absence or disability of the Chief Financial Officer, the Deputy Chief Financial Officer and Treasurer of the District of Columbia is delegated the authority to execute the powers and duties delegated to the Chief Financial Officer as provided in this Order.
3. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective *nunc pro tunc* to October 5, 2009.

SUBJECT: Designation of Recovery Zones Pursuant to the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422 of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22 (2009 Supp.), section 3(e) of The New Convention Center Hotel Emergency Amendment Act of 2009, signed by the Mayor on August 13, 2009 (D.C. Act 18-186), any substantially identical permanent legislation, and sections 1400U-1, 1400U-2, and 1400U-3 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, approved February 17, 2009 (123 Stat. 115; Pub. L. No. 111-5; 26 U.S.C. §§ 1400U-1, 1400U-2, and 1400U-3) (the "Internal Revenue Code"), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. For the purposes of issuing recovery zone economic development bonds and recovery zone facility bonds as defined in sections 1400U-2 and 1400U-3 of the Internal Revenue Code (26 U.S.C. §§ 1400U-2 and 1400U-3), each of the following areas is designated a recovery zone:
 - a. The District of Columbia Enterprise Zone, as defined by section 1400 of the Internal Revenue Code, approved August 5, 1997 (111 Stat. 788; Pub. L. No. 111-34; 26 U.S.C. § 1400), and any areas abutting the District of Columbia Enterprise Zone;
 - b. Each New Community designated as part of the District of Columbia's New Communities Initiative, as defined in section 3(b)(11)(B) of the Housing Production Trust Fund Act of 1988, effective March 16, 1989 (D.C. Law 7-202; D.C. Official Code § 42-2802(b)(11)(B)), including:
 - i. The Park Morton New Community as designated in the Park Morton Redevelopment Initiative Plan Redevelopment Approval Resolution of 2008, effective February 19, 2008 (Res. 17-538; 55 DCR 1881), and bounded by Georgia Avenue, N.W., on the west; Warder Street, N.W., on the east; Lamont Street, N.W., on the south; and Park Road, N.W., on the north;
 - ii. The Barry Farm/Park Chester/Wade Road New Community as designated in the Barry Farm/Park Chester/Wade Road Redevelopment Plan Approval Resolution of 2006, effective

December 19, 2006 (Res. 16-922; 54 DCR 35), and bounded by Firth Sterling Avenue, S.E., on the west; Martin Luther King, Jr. Avenue, S.E., on the east; St. Elizabeths West Campus on the south; and the Suitland Parkway on the north;

iii. The Lincoln Heights/Richardson Dwellings New Community as designated in the Lincoln Heights/Richardson Dwellings New Communities Initiative Revitalization Plan Approval Resolution of 2006, effective December 19, 2006 (Res. 16-923; 54 DCR 38), and bounded by 47th Place, N.E., on the west; 57th Street, N.E., on the east; Blaine Street, N.E., on the south; and Hayes and Jay Streets, N.E. on the north; and

iv. The Northwest One New Communities Project Area as designated in the Northwest One/Sursum Corda Affordable Housing Protection, Preservation and Production Act of 2006, effective November 16, 2006 (D.C. Law 16-188; D.C. Official Code § 6-351.01 *et seq.*), and bounded by New Jersey Avenue, N.W., on the on the west; North Capitol Street on the east; K Street, N.W., on the south; and New York Avenue, N.W., on the north; and

c. Any other area the Mayor designates as a recovery zone.

2. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately.




