Pursuant to DC Official Code Sec 47-361 *et seq.* of the Reprogramming Policy Act of 1990, the Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the Mayor has transmitted the following reprogramming request(s)

A reprogramming will become effective on the 15th day after official receipt unless a Member of the Council files a notice of disapproval of the request which extends the Council's review period to 30 days. If such notice is given, a reprogramming will become effective on the 31st day after its official receipt unless a resolution of approval or disapproval is adopted by the Council prior to that time.

Reprog. 18-74: Request to reprogram \$880,000 of Fiscal Year 2009 Local funds budget authority from the Workforce Investments agency (UP0) to the District of Columbia Public Charter Schools (DCPCS) agency (GC0) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 19, 2009. This reprogramming is necessary to make legally required payments to various public charter schools for services already provided.

Reprog. 18-75: Request to reprogram \$2,000,000 of Fiscal Year 2009 Special Purpose Revenue funds budget authority from the Department of Human Services (DHS) to the Department of Health (DOH) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 19, 2009. This reprogramming is to ensure that the Agency Management Program within DOH has sufficient funds to cover fixed cost spending pressures.

Reprog. 18-76: Request to reprogram \$2,340,020 of Fiscal Year 2009 Local funds budget authority in the Department of Health Care Finance (DHCF) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 20, 2009. This reprogramming will ensure that sufficient budget authority is available to support the accrual for costs associated with the FY 2009 Medicaid provider payments.

Reprog. 18-77: Request to reprogram \$2,551,210 of Fiscal Year 2009 Local funds budget authority from the Settlements and Judgments Fund (ZH0) to the D.C. Unemployment Compensation Fund (BH0), which the Department of Employment Services (CF0) administers was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 23, 2009. This reprogramming will provide the funds required for BH0 to meet higher than anticipated unemployment benefit costs for former District of Columbia Government employees who have recently separated from services.

Reprog. 18-78: Request to reprogram \$19,269,165 of Fiscal Year 2009 Local funds budget authority in the Department of Health Care Finance (DHCF) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 23, 2009. This reprogramming will ensure that Medicaid provider payments are properly allocated among the various provider services lines.

Reprog. 18-79: Request to reprogram \$2,100,000 of Fiscal Year 2009 Local funds budget authority from the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department (FEMS) to the Department of Corrections (DOC) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 25, 2009. This reprogramming will cover costs for required inmate services that have already been provided.

Reprog. 18-80: Request to reprogram \$1,013,682.18 of Fiscal Year 2009 Special Purpose Revenue funds budget within the District Department of Transportation was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 25, 2009. This reprogramming is to ensure that the Department of Transportation has sufficient budget authority to cover revenue that was collected above the budget estimate for the DC Circulator.

Reprog. 18-81: Request to reprogram \$4,000,000 of Fiscal Year 2009 Local funds budget authority from the Office of the State Superintendent of Education (OSSE) to the Non-Public Tuition agency was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 25, 2009. This reprogramming will provide budget authority to Non-Public Tuition to cover costs for services for District students with an approved Individual Education Plan pursuant to the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act.

Reprog. 18-82: Request to reprogram \$3,200,675 of Fiscal Year 2009 Local funds budget authority from certain public works cluster agencies to the Department of Public Works (DPW) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 25, 2009. This reprogramming will offset the cost overruns in the Fleet services due to unanticipated related expenses.

Reprog. 18-83: Request to reprogram \$1,356,839 of capital budget authority and allotment within the Department of Real Estate Services was filed in the Office of the Secretary on November 25, 2009. This reprogramming is needed for construction tasks related to the completion of the New Beginnings facility operated by the Department of Youth Rehabilitative Services in Laurel, Maryland.
