**Reprog. 18-92:** Request to reprogram \$10,934,911.72 of capital budget authority and allotment provided to various capital projects of the District of Columbia Public Schools (DCPS) and the Office of Public Education Facilities Modernization (OPEFM) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on December 17, 2009. This reprogramming of capital budget authority and allotment is being requested from various capital projects that are completed, not currently planned, or funded by other sources.

**Notice of Reprogramming Disapproval**

Councilmembers Barry and M. Brown filed on December 15, 2009, PR 18-658 The "Reprogramming of \$5,124,819.36 for the Department of Housing and Community Development Disapproval Resolution of 2009 " to disapprove Reprogramming 18-86. The request to reprogram \$5,124,819.36 in Local funds from the Metropolitan Police Department and the Department of Employment Services (DOES) to the Department of Housing and Community Development (DHCD) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on December 1, 2009. This reprogramming will provide budget authority to ensure that DHCD has sufficient funds for the Federal Community Development Block Grant.

The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 30 days, ending on Thursday, December 31, 2009. If the Council does not adopt a resolution of approval or disapproval during this period, the reprogramming will be deemed approved on Friday, January 1, 2010.

The "Reprogramming of \$3,501,346 for the District of Columbia Public Schools Disapproval Resolution of 2009 " to disapprove Reprogramming 18-91. The request to reprogram \$3,501,346 of Fiscal Year 2009 Local funds budget authority from the Contract Appeals Board (AF0) \$38,900, Department of Real Estate Services (AM0) \$1,100,000, D.C. Department of Human Resources (BE0) \$38,000, Office of the Attorney General (CB0) \$500,000, Repayment of Loans and Interest (DS0) \$44,900, Workforce Investments (UP0) \$988,000, Repayment of Interest on Short Term Borrowing (ZA0) \$205,546, Department of Mental Health (RM0) \$56,000, and the Executive Office of the Mayor (AA0) \$530,000 to the District of Columbia Public Schools (GA0) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on December 1, 2009. This reprogramming is necessary to align \$3,001,346 budget authority for FY 2009 fixed costs for the agency, and \$500,000 to cover the Realty Office expenditures.

The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 30 days, ending on Thursday, December 31, 2009. If the Council does not adopt a resolution of approval or disapproval during this period, the reprogramming will be deemed approved on Friday, January 1, 2010.
