Councilmember Kwame R. Brown, Chair of the Committee on Economic Development, announces a Public Hearing to consider B18-050, the “Mixed – Income Housing Amendment Act of 2009”; B18-250, the “Senior Housing Modernization Grant Fund Act of 2009”; and B18-399, the “Pennsylvania Avenue-Minnesota Avenue S.E. Eminent Domain Authorization Act of 2009”.

Bill 18-050, the “Mixed-Income Housing Amendment Act of 2009” will amend an Act authorizing the sale of certain real estate in the District of Columbia no longer required for public purposes to include an affordable housing requirement as part of the disposition. This Bill will also amend the Office of Property Management Establishment Act of 1998 to require the Office of Property Management to include an affordable housing requirement as part of the disposition of real property.

Bill 18-250, the “Senior Housing Modernization Grant Fund Act of 2009” would establish a Senior Citizens Housing Modernization Grant Fund and authorize the Deputy

Mayor for Planning and Economic Development to make grants from the Fund for repairs and improvements to single-family dwellings owned by qualified senior citizens if they reside in an area affected by a planned-unit development.

Bill 18-399, the "Pennsylvania Avenue-Minnesota Avenue S.E., Eminent Domain Authorization Act of 2009" would allow the Mayor to exercise eminent domain authority to acquire property at the intersection of Pennsylvania Avenue and Minnesota Avenue, S.E., as part of the overall revitalization of the Ward 7 corridor of Pennsylvania Avenue.
