Councilmember Phil Mendelson, Chairperson of the Committee on Public Safety and the Judiciary, announces a public oversight roundtable on continuing overtime and pay problems in the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department. The purpose of the oversight roundtable is to hear and receive testimony on two issues. First, the Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department's management and control of overtime spending. FEMS has overspent its overtime budget the last several years and is on track to do so again by double. Second, FEMS continues to suffer pay problems that are detrimental to agency personnel. The roundtable will focus on what measures FEMS is undertaking to reduce the agency's use of overtime and to correct ongoing problems with regard to pay. Testimony will be limited to these two issues. A similar roundtable was held on January 20, 2010 and the Committee will continue to hold these oversight hearings until these two problems are under control.
