Reprog. 18-102: Request to reprogram \$33,381,404 of capital budget authority and allotment between various capital projects to facilitate the completion of final Bearing Point reconciliation adjustments was filed in the Office of the Secretary on March 3, 2010. This reprogramming is necessary to ensure that remaining project budgets are realigned with budget corrections required following a study of historical budgets in the financial system of record (SOAR) and actual appropriated amounts.
