Mayor's Order 2010-43
March 8, 2010

SUBJECT: Designation of the Office of Justice Grants Administration as the District of Columbia's authorized entity to apply for and administer all grants and other federal initiatives for the purpose of creating or improving programs, policies and coordination for the District's juvenile and criminal justice systems, including applying for funding under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor, Justice Grants Administration

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(2), (6), and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, Pub. L. No. 93-198, 87 Stat. 790, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22 (2), (6), and (11) (2009 Supp.), and in accordance with the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, ("Act"), approved September 7, 1974, Pub. L. 93-415, 88 Stat.1109, it is hereby **ORDERED** that Mayor's Order 2000-149, dated October 3, 2000, is hereby amended as follows:

I. BACKGROUND AND PURPOSE:

- A. On February 17, 2009, President Barack Obama signed the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009 ("ARRA"), approved February 17, 2009, Pub. L. 111-5, 123 Stat. 115, into law. The ARRA presents an unprecedented opportunity to preserve and create jobs, to invest in infrastructure, to develop energy efficiency and new technology initiatives, to provide assistance to the unemployed, to train and educate the workforce, and to stimulate future economic growth.
- B. The Justice Grants Administration (JGA) is the sole agency responsible for carrying out the provisions of the Act in the District of Columbia.
- C. JGA, as the District of Columbia's State Administering Agency, is responsible for all community-based programs designed to provide for the District's juvenile and criminal justice systems, including, but not limited to, those listed in part II of this order.

II. APPOINTMENT OF THE JGA AS THE AUTHORIZED ENTITY TO RECEIVE AND ADMINISTER ALL FEDERAL GRANTS TO IMPROVE PROGRAMS, POLICIES AND COORDINATION FOR THE DISTRICT'S JUVENILE AND CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEMS.

A. The JGA is hereby appointed as the authorized entity for the District of Columbia for the purpose of applying for and administering all federal grants for the District's juvenile and criminal justice systems including, but not necessarily limited to grants emanating from:

1. ARRA;
2. Byrne/Justice Assistance Grant (JAG);
3. Residential Substance Abuse Treatment (RSAT);
4. Title II Formula Grants Program;
5. Title V Delinquency Prevention Program;
6. Enforcing Underage Drinking Laws Program;
7. Juvenile Accountability Block Grant Program; and
8. Paul Coverdell Forensic Science Improvement Program.

B. The JGA is also appointed as the authorized entity for the District of Columbia to administer grants from local funds as may be provided by available appropriations and grant-making authority conferred by local law.

C. The JGA is also appointed as the authorized entity for the District of Columbia for any other grant program which is necessary or proper for the purpose of improving the criminal and juvenile justice community in the District of Columbia.

III. RESPONSIBILITIES OF JGA

As the State Administering Agency, JGA shall provide the necessary support, access, authority, oversight and reporting required of the District with regard to the programmatic, financial and reporting obligations associated with the grants received and administered by it.

IV. RATIFICATION

All actions previously taken by JGA consistent with this Mayor’s Order are hereby ratified.

V. EFFECTIVE DATE: This Order shall become effective immediately




SUBJECT: Delegation of Rulemaking Authority under D.C. Official Code § 5-722 (c)
Regarding the Police and Firemen's Retirement and Relief Board

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(2), (6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22 (2), (6) and (11) (2009 Supp.), and pursuant to section 122 (c) of the Policemen and Firemen's Retirement and Disability Act (Act), approved September 3, 1974, Pub. L. 93-407, D.C. Official Code § 5-722 (c) (2008 Repl.), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. The Director of the D.C. Department of Human Resources is delegated the authority vested in the Mayor by section 122 (c) of the Act (D.C. Official Code § 5-722 (c)) (2008 Repl.) to issue rules governing the Police and Firemen's Retirement and Relief Board.
2. This Order supersedes any prior Mayor's Order to the extent of any inconsistency therein.
3. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall become effective immediately.


SUBJECT: Appointment – Child Fatality Review Committee


SUBJECT: Appointment – District of Columbia Financial Literacy Council


SUBJECT: Appointment – Interim People's Counsel
