Councilmember David A. Catania, Chair of the Committee on Health, announces a Public Hearing on B18-674, the Medicaid Benefits Protection Amendment Act of 2010. The hearing will be May 3, 2010 at 4:00 p.m., or at the conclusion of the FY11 budget hearing for the Department of Health Care Finance. The hearing will be held in Room 123 of the John A. Wilson Building, 1350 Pennsylvania Avenue, NW.

The purpose of this hearing is to consider legislation that will amend the Medicaid Benefits Protection Act of 1994 consistent with the requirements of the Deficit Reduction Act of 2005 to require health insurers that are legally responsible for the payment of a claim for a health care item or service to provide information about individuals who were eligible for or received medical assistance, and to amend the requirements for health insurers to reimburse the District for medical assistance it provided.

Testimony may be limited to 3 minutes per witness and 5 minutes for a panel of witnesses.
