

Notice of Reprogramming Disapproval

Councilmember Barry filed on April 29, 2010 PR 18-844. The "Reprogramming No. 18-112 Disapproval Resolution of 2010" to Disapprove Reprogramming 18-112. The request to reprogram \$4,278,000 of capital budget authority and allotment with the Office of the Deputy Mayor for Planning and Economic Development was filed in the Office of the Secretary on April 20, 2010. This reprogramming is necessary to fund a contract with Waterfront Associates, LLC, for construction of 4th Street, SW, through the former Waterside Mall site.

The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 30 days, ending on Thursday, May 20, 2010. If the Council does not adopt a resolution of approval or disapproval during this period, the reprogramming will be deemed approved on Friday, May 21, 2010.

Councilmember Alexander filed on April 29, 2010 PR 18-846. The "Reprogramming No. 18-113 Disapproval Resolution of 2010" to Disapprove Reprogramming 18-113. The request to reprogram \$4,275,131 of capital budget within the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on April 26, 2010. This reprogramming will realign the budget for certain DPR projects to meet the project scope and schedule developed jointly by DPR and OPEFM.

The disapproval resolution extends the Council's review period to 30 days, ending on Thursday, May 20, 2010. If the Council does not adopt a resolution of approval or disapproval during this period, the reprogramming will be deemed approved on Friday, May 21, 2010.
