NOTICE OF CONTRACT DISAPPROVAL RESOLUTION

The Council of the District of Columbia gives notice that the resolution listed below to disapprove CA 18-297, proposed FY-2010-2011 Annual Capital Transportation Plan for All Sources (Plan) between the Federal Highway Administration, the Government of the District of Columbia (District) and the now defunct District of Columbia Financial Responsibility and Management Assistance Authority. The projects in this year's program including, but are not limited to: Economic Stimulus projects funded by the American Recovery and Rehabilitation Act (STIMULUS); bridge design and construction, inspection and risk assessment; street (including local) design and construction; streetlight system upgrading, preservation, preventative maintenance and upgrade of District tunnels; construction of wheelchair ramps and the assessment, design and construction of other features required to comply with Americans with Disabilities Act; traffic signal maintenance and construction; integrated asset management database development; safety improvements; and various transportation studies financed with FHWA funds was filed in the Office of the Secretary on May 5, 2010.

Reprog. 18-118: Request to reprogram \$1,500,000 of Fiscal Year 2010 Special Purpose Revenue fund budget authority from the Office of the Chief Financial Officer (OCFO) to the Office of the Chief Technology Officer (OCTO) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on May 14, 2010. This reprogramming is needed to ensure DC-Net's budget authority is in line with its collections and operating spending plan.

Reprog. 18-119: Request to reprogram \$4,008,925 of capital budget authority and allotment within the Office of Public Education Facilities Modernization was filed in the Office of the Secretary on May 14, 2010. This reprogramming is necessary to fund fit-out of swing-space for Wilson High School, to include design and construction changes to accommodate 1,350 students and an acceleration of the construction schedule to allow students to use the space in August 2010.

Reprog. 18-120: Request to reprogram \$933,067 of FY 2010 Local funds budget authority within the Department of Mental Health (DMH) was filed in the Office of the Secretary on May 14, 2010. This reprogramming is needed in (SEH) to meet the hospital's needs for staff training, contracted medical and professional services, and maintenance of the physical plant, and in MHRS to reduce the projected spending pressure in the program's local match budget.
