SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority Pursuant to the "Vending Regulation Act of 2009"

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by sections 422(6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act of 1973, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code §§ 1-204.22(6) and (11) (2008 Supp.), and the Vending Regulation Act of 2009 ("Act"), effective October 22, 2009, D.C. Law 18-71, 56 DCR 45, it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

- I. Delegation of Authority
 1. The Director, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, is delegated the authority to coordinate all vending activities in the District of Columbia; to administer licensing provisions pursuant to Section 3(c) of the Act; to distribute vending site permits for vending locations; to designate the categories of merchandise or services that may be vended under specific classes of vending business licenses; to establish hours of operation for vendors and vending locations; to establish standards for the design, maintenance, and operation of vendors and vending equipment; and to promulgate regulations to implement the Act.
 2. The Director, Department of Transportation, is delegated the authority to designate vending locations on sidewalks, roadways, and other public spaces, pursuant to Section 4(a) of the Act; to designate locations on public space for public markets, pursuant to Section 4(b) of the Act; and to implement administrative provisions and promulgate and enforce rules for the regulation of newspaper vending stands.
 3. The Director, Department of Health, is delegated the authority to designate the categories of food that may be vended by vendors; to inspect food vending operations, including vending depots; to administer licensure or certification for the handling of food; and to enforce the application of Title 25 of the District of Columbia Municipal Regulations, including the creation of a schedule of fines for civil infractions, to vendors.
 4. The Chief, Fire and Emergency Medical Services Department, is delegated the authority to administer the permitting of open flame and

propane gas in vending operations; and to conduct fire safety-related inspections of vending businesses.

5. The Chief, Metropolitan Police Department, is delegated the authority to enforce District laws and regulations governing vending activities.
6. The Chief, Metropolitan Police Department, and the Director, Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs, are jointly delegated the authority to enforce provisions of Sections 3(a), 4(b), and 5(a).

II. Rescission

1. Mayor's Order 2009-106, dated June 16, 2009, is repealed.
2. Mayor's Order 2008-66, dated April 23, 2008, is repealed.
3. Mayor's Order 1985-151, dated September 9, 1985, is repealed.
4. Mayor's Order 1982-186, dated October 25, 1982, is repealed.
5. Mayor's Order 1982-137, dated July 13, 1982, is repealed.
6. Mayor's Order 1980-55, dated February 1, 1980, is repealed.
7. Commissioner's Order 74-268, dated December 27, 1974, is rescinded.
8. This Order supersedes all previous Mayor's Orders, to the extent of any inconsistency therein.

III. Effective Date

This Order shall be effective immediately.


SUBJECT: Appointment – District of Columbia Cable Television Advisory Committee

Pursuant to Mayor's Order 2008-63, effective April 10, 2008


ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(6) and (11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, as amended, 87 Stat. 790, Pub. L. No. 93-198, D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(6) (2009 Supp.), and section 7 of the Homeless Services Reform Act of 2005, effective October 22, 2005 (D.C. Law 16-35; D.C. Official Code § 4-753.01) (2008 Repl.), it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. The Mayor may extend temporary rental assistance provided pursuant to Section III.C of Mayor's Order 2008-63, effective April 10, 2008, beyond the two year time period for up to one additional year when: (1) the leasehold residence was expected to be ready for re-occupancy within the two year period but is not yet ready; (2) the household is in compliance with the program's rules; and (3) the household continues to demonstrate an inability to pay the full amount of the rent in the relocated unit.
2. This Order supersedes any other previously issued Mayor's Orders to the extent such provisions are inconsistent with this Order.
3. **EFFECTIVE DATE:** This Order shall be effective *nunc pro tunc* to March 1, 2010.

SUBJECT: Establishment - Mayor's Health Reform Implementation Committee

ORIGINATING AGENCY: Office of the Mayor

By virtue of the authority vested in me as Mayor of the District of Columbia by section 422(11) of the District of Columbia Home Rule Act, approved December 24, 1973 (Pub. L. 93-198, 87 Stat. 790; D.C. Official Code § 1-204.22(11) (2009 Supp.)), it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

I. ESTABLISHMENT

There is hereby established in the Executive Branch of the Government of the District of Columbia, the Mayor's Health Reform Implementation Committee (hereinafter referred to as the "Committee").

II. PURPOSE

The Committee shall advise the Mayor on implementation of the federal Patient Protection and Affordable Care Act, approved March 23, 2010 (Pub. L. 111-148; 124 Stat. 119) and the Health Care and Education Reconciliation Act of 2010, approved March 30, 2010 (Pub. L. 111-152; 124 Stat. 1029).

III. FUNCTIONS

The functions of the Committee shall include advising the Mayor on implementation of federal health reform and coordination of health reform in the District of Columbia.

IV. COMPOSITION

- a. The Committee shall be comprised of not less than four (4) members appointed by the Mayor.
- b. The members appointed to the Committee shall include:
 1. The Commissioner of the Department of Insurance, Securities, and Banking;
 2. The Director of the Department of Health Care Finance;
 3. The Director of the Department of Health;
 4. The Director of the Department of Human Services; and
 5. Any other individuals representing an agency within the Executive Branch of the Government of the District of Columbia, as designated by the Mayor.

V. TERMS

The members of the Committee shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor.

VI. COMPENSATION

All members of the Committee shall serve without compensation.

VII. ORGANIZATIONS

- a. The Commissioner of the Department of Insurance, Securities, and Banking and the Director of the Department of Health Care Finance shall serve as co-chairpersons of the Committee.
- b. The Committee may establish subcommittees as needed. Subcommittees may include persons who are not members of the full Committee, provided that each subcommittee shall be chaired by a Committee member.
- c. Members appointed by the Mayor may designate in writing alternate members to attend meetings on their behalf.
- d. The Commissioner of the Department of Insurance, Securities, and Banking, the Director of the Department of Health Care Finance, the Director of the Department of Health, the Director of the Department of Human Services, and any director of a District agency appointed to the Committee pursuant to paragraph b.4 of this section may appoint a delegate to serve on the Committee on his or her behalf.

VIII. ADMINISTRATION

The Department of Insurance, Securities, and Banking, the Department of Health Care Finance, the Department of Health, and the Department of Human Services shall provide administrative, clerical, and technical support to the Committee.

IX. SUNSET

The Committee shall sunset on January 31, 2014.

XI. EFFECTIVE DATE: This order shall be effective immediately.
